## New Neighbors – Remember Your Residential Parking Permits!

Resident Only hang tags are required on the 5100 and 5200 blocks of Pershing, Milam and Alcott each night of the week starting at either 8 or 9pm. These tags may be purchased for \$6.50 from the City of Dallas by filling out an application that can be found at: http://dallascityhall.com/pdf/Vehicle HangtagApplication.pdf and mailing to the City of Dallas Parking Services Office, 1200 Ross St, #102, Dallas, 75202 [Ross & Field]. You can also get these hang tags in person. Their number is: 214 754-4784 You may purchase up to 6 tags and they are good for one year. You must have a driver's license with the current address on it, a recent utility bill or lease agreement and proof of vehicle insurance.

**Beware!** The city issues parking violation citations almost every night of the week! Also, you could get cited for parking the wrong way on the street or blocking the sidewalk with your vehicle.

### Crime Statistics: March 27 – July 9, 2009

It is extremely disturbing that four separate houses were broken into -on four separate streets over the course of six weeks -- and large amounts of items were stolen from all of them. The houses were entered through the rear doors twice and a side window once, all at different times of day or night. In each case, multiple trips were made to unload dozens of items including giant flat screen TVs, computers, power tools and other equipment, and untold amounts of small valuables. These burglaries could not have happened in a flash and had to be done with a vehicle to haul the goods, yet apparently no one noticed them as they were happening.

Folks, we need to protect ourselves and we need to look out for each other, and please use common sense. Keep all doors closed locked at all times - whether you are home or not including garage doors. When you are not home, have a working, monitored house alarm on all of your doors, and motion sensors inside. A major bonus and deterrent to crime is having dogs that bark, and are at home when you are not. Vary your routine from day to day, and leave lights on and make the house look occupied. Watch out for your neighbors and their houses, and if you see any strange vehicles or people hanging around the area, call

911 immediately. Do not confront strangers yourself. Take down license plate numbers and descriptions of suspects, and give them to the police. Just because you have a privacy fence, doesn't mean you are safe.


